Description of Green Projects

Eika Boligkreditt intends to allocate the net proceeds of the Green Bonds to a loan portfolio of new and existing loans in the following category:

- Green Buildings: New or existing residential buildings belonging to the top 15% most energy-efficient buildings of the local building stock and refurbished buildings which achieved energy savings of at least 30% in comparison to the baseline performance of the building before the renovation.

Eligibility Criteria to select the Eligible Green Loan Portfolio are set out in the Eika Boligkreditt Green Bond Framework 2021.

Eika Boligkreditt has relied on the support of external specialised consultant Multiconsult to calculate the impact indicators of the Eligible Portfolio.
